***Responsive Reading for John 3:14-21**

Pastor: At a time when humankind had exhausted its own efforts to know and be known by God, the Word became flesh and lived among us. (John 1:14.) Jesus came to us; God with us, revealing God to us.

People: Jesus came to us, the ultimate act of hospitality

Pastor: Jesus remained with us for a time, in spite of our dull understanding and willful acts against God. He emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, being born in human likeness. He humbled himself and submitted to the humiliation of death on a cross.

People: Jesus came to us in the ultimate act of self-sacrifice.
