## Mark 9:2-9 MEV

Let us make three sanctuaries: one for You, and one for Moses, and one for Elijah." 6 For he did not know what to say, because they were very afraid. 7 Then a cloud overshadowed them, and a voice came out of the cloud, saying, "This is My beloved Son. Listen to Him." 8 Suddenly, when they looked around, they no longer saw anyone with them except Jesus only. 9 As they came down the mountain, He warned them to tell no one what they had seen, until the Son of Man had risen from the dead.

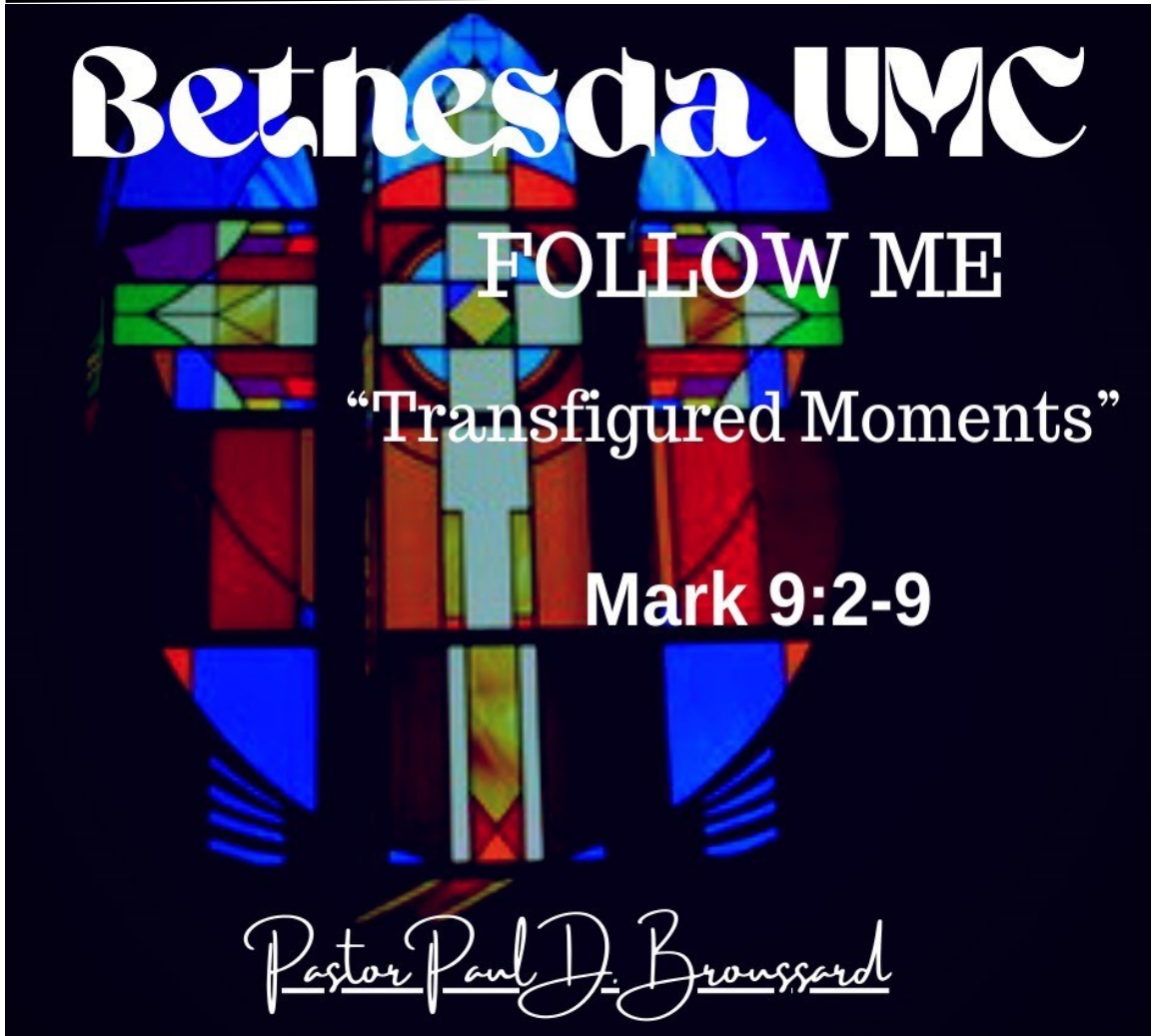
