## Philippians 2:5-11 MEV

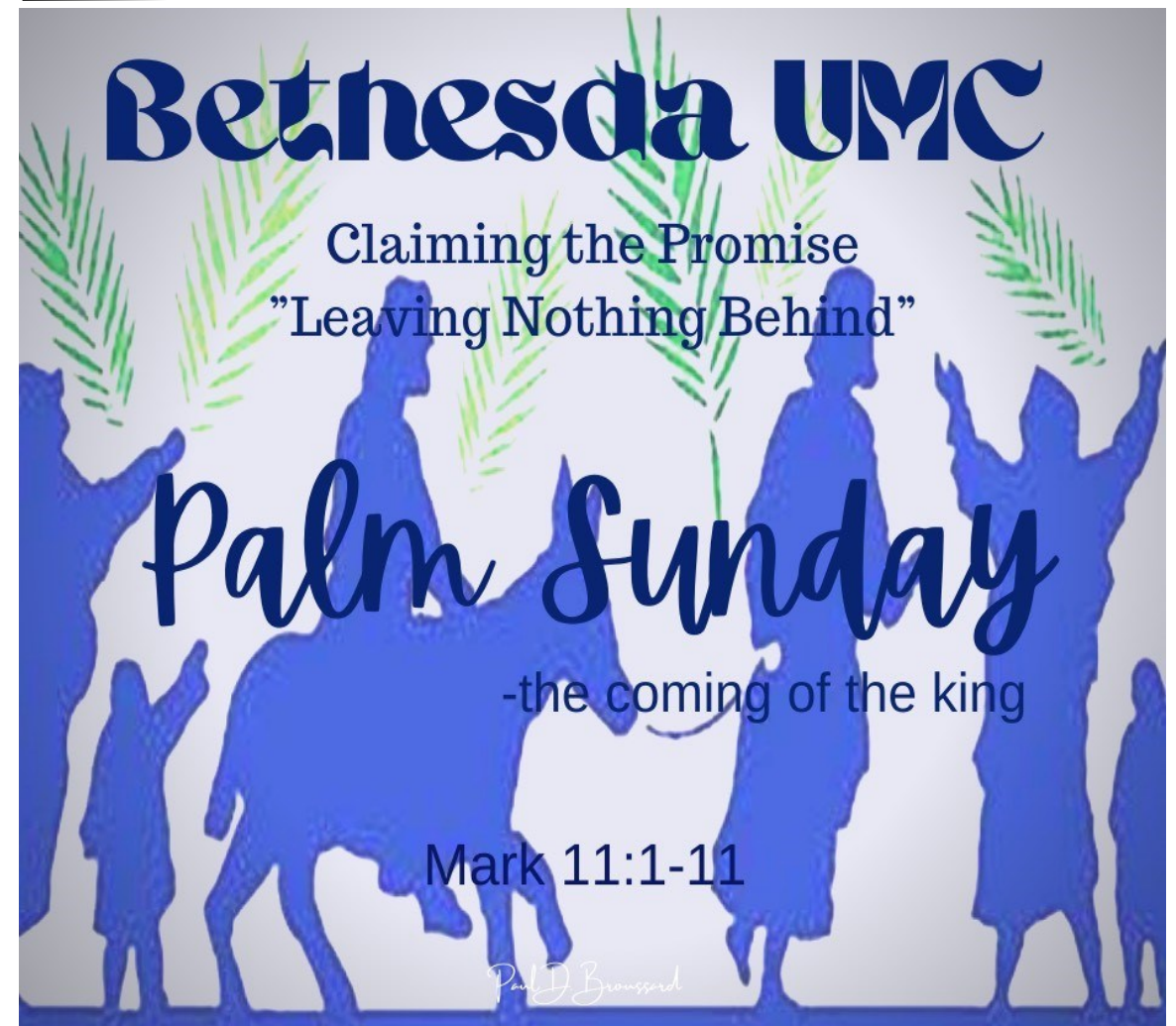
5 Let this mind be in you all, which was also in Christ Jesus,  
6 who, being in the form of God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped.  
7 But He emptied Himself, taking upon Himself the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men.  
8 And being found in the form of a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to death, even death on a cross. 9 Therefore God highly exalted Him and gave Him the name which is above every name,  
10 that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven and on earth and under the earth,  
11 and every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

## Mark 11:1-11 MEV

11 When they drew near Jerusalem and came to Bethphage and Bethany at the Mount of Olives, He sent out two of His disciples 2 and said to them, "Go into the village opposite you. As soon as you enter it, you will find a colt tied, on which no one has ever sat. Untie it and bring it here. 3 If anyone says to you, 'Why are you doing this?' say 'The Lord has need of it,' and immediately he will send it here." 4 They went their way and found the colt tied by the door outside on the street. And they untied it. 5 Some of those who stood there said to them, "What are you doing untying the colt?" 6 They answered just as Jesus had commanded. And they let them go. 7 They brought the colt to Jesus and threw their garments on it. And He sat upon it. 8 Many spread their garments on the street. And others cut down branches off the trees and scattered them on the street. 9 Those who went before and those who followed cried out, saying:  
"Hosanna! 'Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord!'  
10 Blessed is the kingdom of our father David that is coming in the name of the Lord!  
Hosanna in the highest!"  
11 Jesus entered Jerusalem and went into the temple. When He had looked around at everything, as the hour was now late, He went out to Bethany with the twelve.
