 - A. Hotdogs – pre-cooked and wrapped in tin-foil
Individual packets of condiments
 - B. Small bag of chips – handed out upon request
 - C. Drinks in cooler – handed out upon request
 - D. Chili – Volunteer dipped and adding all fixing:
cheese, crackers, sour crème upon request
- Trunks set up
 - A. Half circle at the front of the church.
 - B. 6ft between each car
- Candy disbursement
 - A. Each trunk worker should hand out candy – no open grab bowls/bags. Candy can be placed in inexpensive cups or bags and placed on a table or slid down a chute
